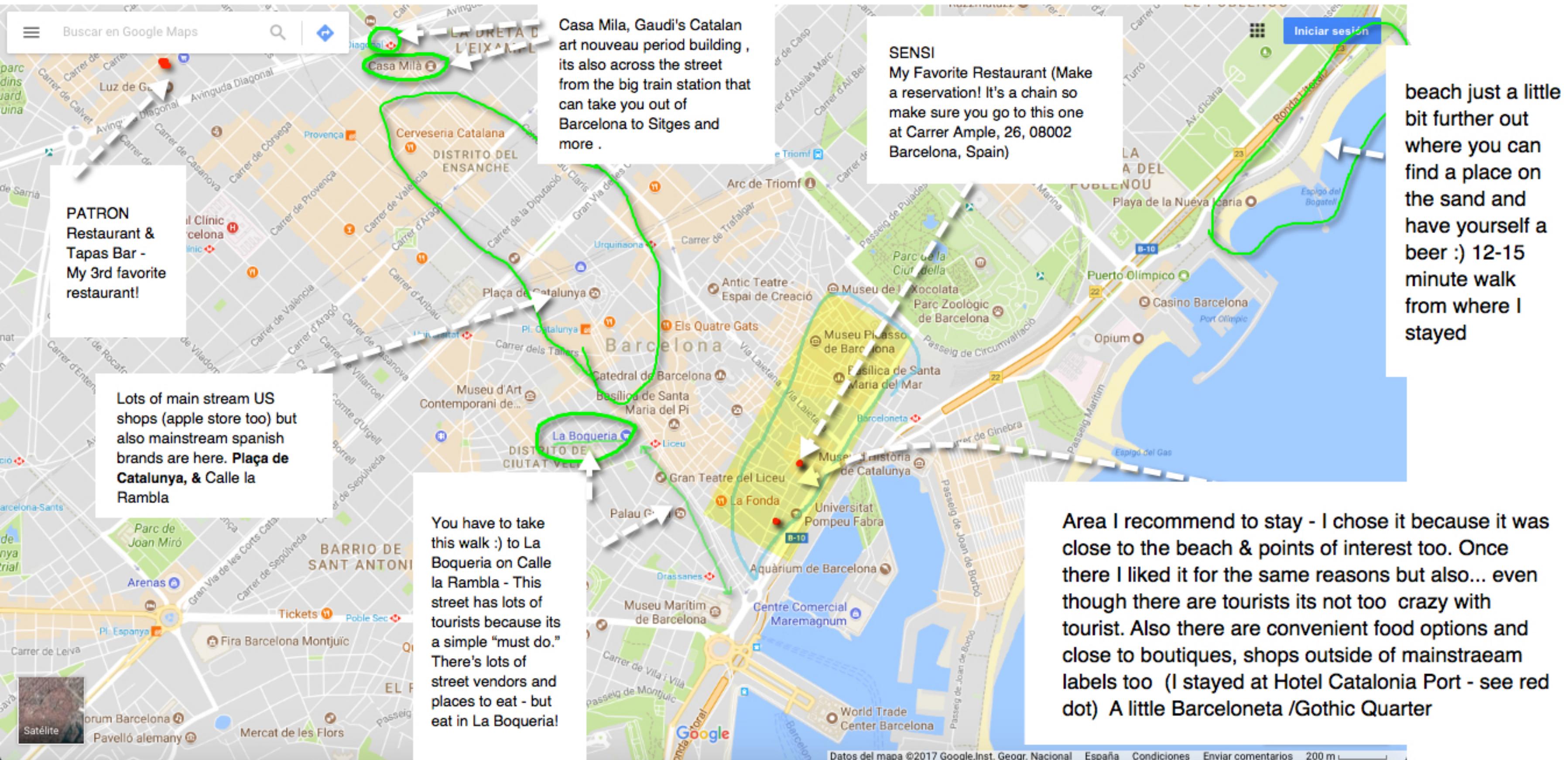


# BARCELONA, SPAIN

Lots of main stream US shops (apple store too) but also mainstream spanish brands are here. **Plaça de Catalunya, & Calle la Rambla**

You have to take this walk :) to La Boqueria on Calle la Rambla - This street has lots of tourists because its a simple "must do." There's lots of street vendors and places to eat - but eat in La Boqueria!
